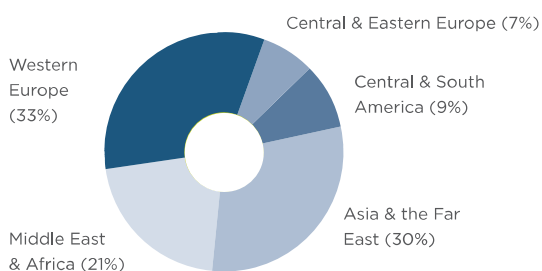

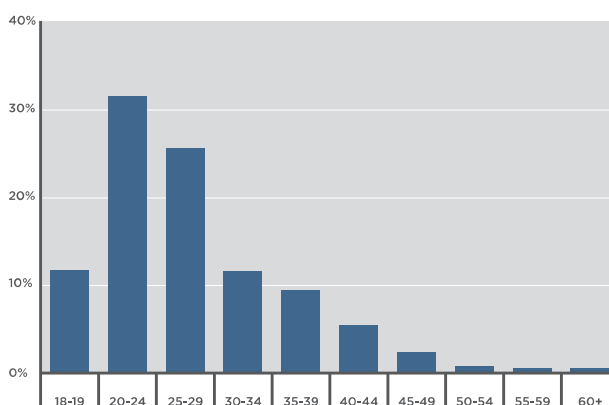
## Where our clients come from

Age profile of participants on all scheduled courses. (Average age **28**).

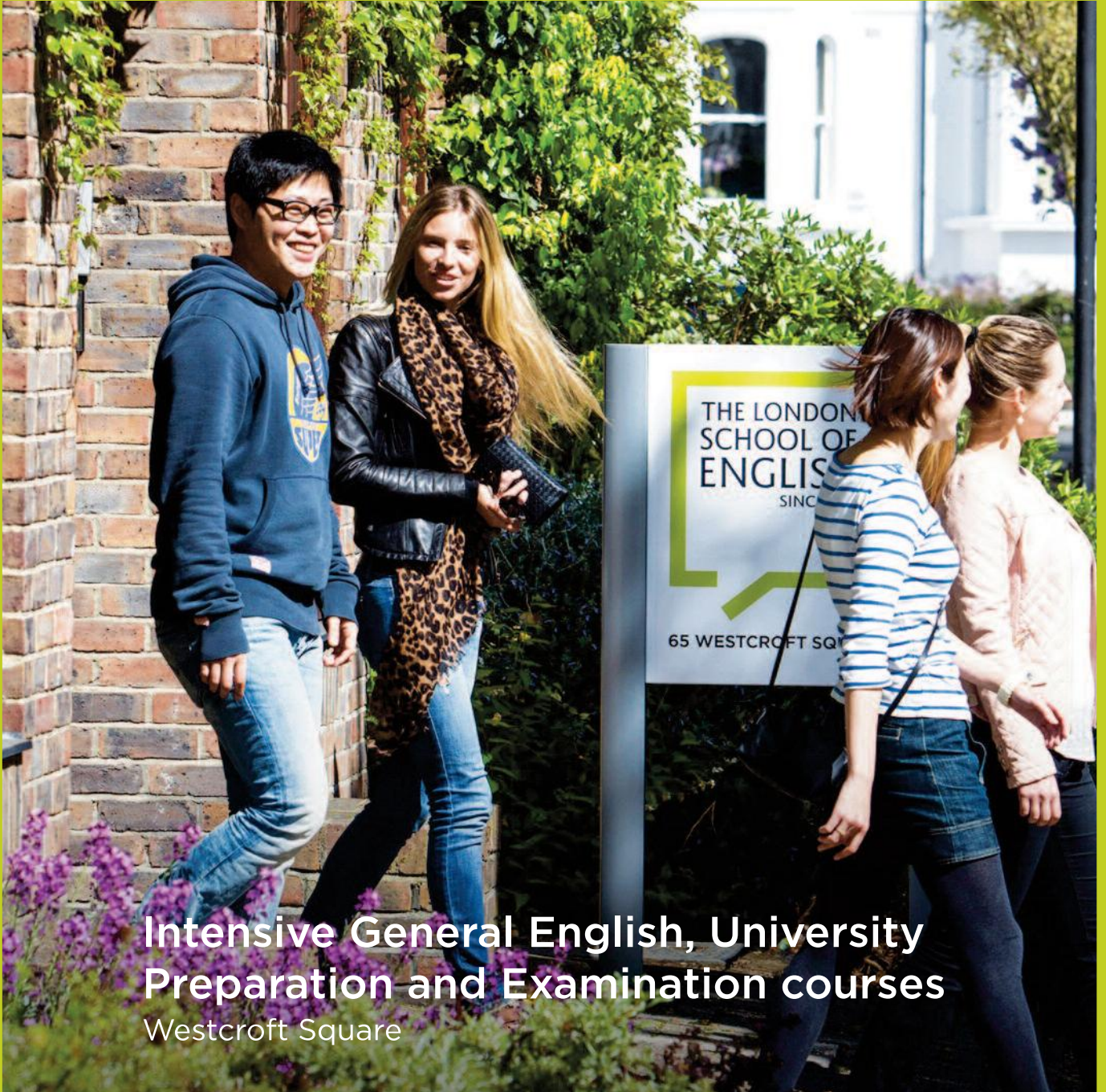

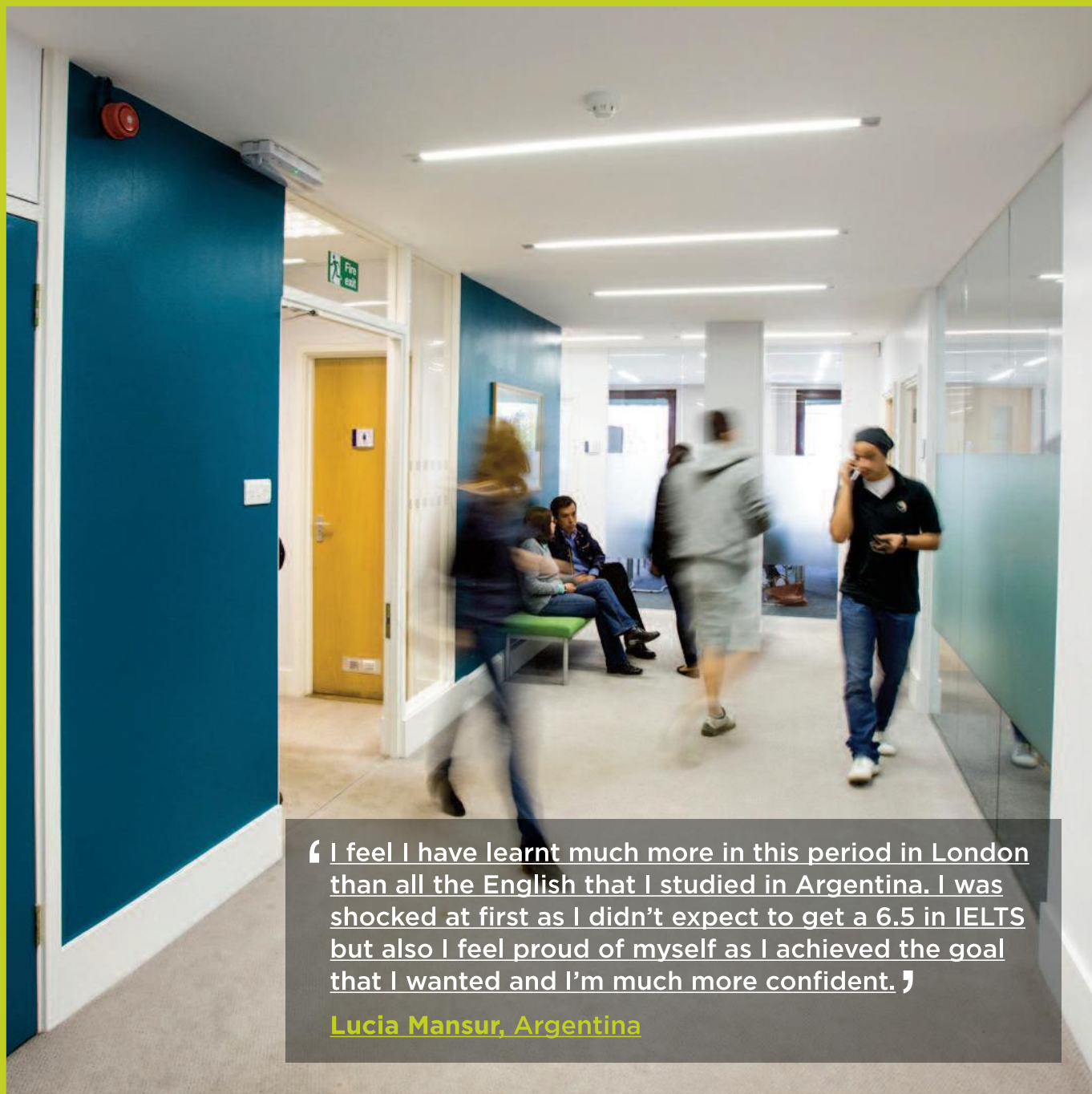
