

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Cornerstone Programs



Graduated ESL

Cornerstone's ESL program consists of levels from beginner to advanced. We offer two different streams to fit both schedule and budget. The first is 20-hour General ESL, consisting of an integrated skills morning class. The second is 28-hour Intensive ESL, consisting of the morning class and additional afternoon classes, which focus on a wide variety of specializations. Each class is taught by different teachers, giving students exposure to a variety of effective teaching styles.

Upon arrival, students take our placement test and an oral interview. Students are placed in to one of the following Cornerstone ESL levels:

LOWER LEVELS

Level 1 – Beginner

Level 2 – High Beginner

Level 3 – Pre-Intermediate

INTERMEDIATE LEVELS

Level 4 - Intermediate

Level 5 - Upper Intermediate

HIGHER LEVELS

Level 6 - Pre-Advanced

Level 7 - Advanced

Level 8 – Upper Advanced

Real Speaking

As an alternative to the Graduated ESL classes, the intensive 8-week Real Speaking program focuses entirely on improving speaking ability through a combination of grammar, pronunciation, listening, and vocabulary in realistic and relevant, theme-based lessons. Students are challenged through this mixture to utilize the presented language in a concentrated context during the morning. Students take a media-based lesson in the afternoon, focusing on current events and news-related vocabulary.

Business English

Cornerstone offers two divisions of Business English: Intensive (28 hours per week) and General (20 hours per week). Students can study for the entire 12 weeks or study 4 to 8 weeks if their time is limited. Cornerstone's Business English curriculum covers a wide range of business themes, including e-commerce, customer service, and the future of business. All of the language skills (reading, writing, listening and speaking, as well as grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation) are studied within the context of the business theme. In the afternoon, business elective classes in English for Marketing and Advertising, International Business and Business Presentations give students a chance to learn and practice their business skills

intensively. The learning process in this program is enhanced by attending business conferences and seminars whenever possible.

TOEFL (iBT) Prep.

It is recommended that students take this full-time course for 12 weeks, but registration on a monthly basis is available. Students become very familiar with the four sections of the test and the different kinds of questions in each. Specific and detailed test taking and time management skills are introduced and practiced extensively. Our experienced and qualified instructor brings special attention to areas that need focus and improvement. Cornerstone Academic College is recognized as an official TOEFL testing centre.

TOEIC Prep. / TOEIC Speaking

The TOEIC class meets for approximately 9 hours per week. Because ever increasing importance is put on successful scores on TOEIC as a criterion for employment and promotion in many businesses, our TOEIC curriculum focuses on raising students' potential by covering the exam in detail. Our experienced and qualified instructor guides students through each section of the test with in-depth analysis. A series of practice and monthly institutional tests give ample opportunity

for practice and review. Cornerstone Academic College is recognized as an official TOEIC testing centre.

C.E.E.P (College Entrance Exam Prep.)

The C.E.E.P is a 4, 8 or 12 week, 6-hour-a-day program, designed for students who need to pass a college's English proficiency test in order to enter a Canadian college. College entrance exams focus primarily on grammar, reading and writing, and Cornerstone's program, therefore, focuses on these three areas, as well as on building a student's vocabulary. Enrolling in Cornerstone's C.E.E.P will prepare international students for their college English proficiency test and make the taking of the test a less stressful event.

TESOL

Cornerstone's TESOL Program is a 4-week, 6-hour a day program, designed to teach non-native speakers who wish to pursue a career teaching ESL how to teach the English language communicatively. The course covers various theories regarding how language is learned and equips teachers with the skills and experience necessary to effectively guide students into a functioning use of the language. To facilitate learning through experience, a teaching practicum is included.

Students who successfully complete the program will be awarded both a Cornerstone diploma as well as a certificate from American TESOL Institute (ATI), an affiliate of TESOL in the United States.





TEYC

Cornerstone's Teaching English to Young Children course is aimed at non-native speakers of English who

would like to prepare themselves to teach young children in their home countries. The course will cover the theory necessary for effective and informed teaching, but will focus as much as possible on the practical aspects involved.

Students who successfully complete the program will be awarded both a Cornerstone diploma as well as a certificate from American TESOL Institute (ATI), an affiliate of TESOL in the United States. Conerstone is also an official testing centre for the Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT) from Cambridge ESOL.





College Pathway

Cornerstone has a partnership with Centennial College, one of Canada's oldest, largest and most recognized public institutions located in Toronto, Ontario. Students who successfully complete four months of Intensive Advanced ESL will now be directly accepted into over 90% of Centennial College programs

without further English assessment or the submission of TOEFL or IELTS scores. Cornerstone also has a partnership with Lambton College and Algonquine College.

AH & LA Certificate Prep.

Cornerstone's AH & LA Certificate Prep. program consists of six modules: Management of Front Office Operation, Food and Beverage Services and Operation Management, Convention Management and Service, Supervision in the Hospitality Industry, Hospitality and Tourism Marketing and Hospitality Sales & Marketing.

Each module is approved by the American Hotel and Lodging Association (AH&LA), which is governed by the largest hotel chains in the world. Classes are administered in English by a qualified teacher who has vast experience with major hotel chains.

Since on-site training is vital in hospitality management, we provide the very best internships to those who qualify in major hotel chains in Toronto. We also provide Business English, Job Interview and Pronunciation courses to fully prepare students for their internships. For the overseas student, this program offers a convenient way to receive a globally recognized certificate, beneficial in finding employment in their home country.

Student Orientation

Student ID card

Every student at Cornerstone is entitled to receive an official Cornerstone Student Identification Card. This card will enable you to receive valuable discounts on many services and activities while studying in Canada.

Lounge Around

Making friends is vital to a healthy student life. You will learn so much from conversing, sharing and exchanging ideas with other students. We ask you to sit, have coffee, laugh and talk in our student lounge designed specifically for this purpose.

Airport Pick-up & Drop-off

Airport service is provided from Pearson International Airport in Toronto or vice-versa. Students must notify Cornerstone of their flight itinerary well in advance. Please note there is a separate charge for this service.

Transportation

Toronto has extensive subway and bus lines to take you where you need to go quickly and easily. A monthly metropass will allow you to use the bus, subway, and streetcar without limitations.

Medical Insurance

It is mandatory for all students to have their own health care insurance policies with enough coverage to last the full length of their stay in Canada. However, in the case that they do not, Cornerstone will assist them in making the necessary arrangements.

Visa Information

Student Visa

A visa is needed by all international students who wish to study for longer than 6 months in Canada. Students must apply for a Student Authorization at a Canadian embassy or consulate before they leave for Canada. Authorization usually takes from 1 to 3 months to process. It is important that you plan ahead.

- To apply for a Student Visa, you will need:
- A current passport
 An official Letter of Acceptance from Cornerstone Academic

- 3. Proof of sufficient funds for living expenses
- 4. In some countries, a medical examination is needed

Visitor's Visa

When international travelers arrive at Pearson International Airport in Toronto, they are given a Port of Entry stamp on their passports. As a visitor, you are permitted to stay for 6 months. However, please note that this condition is not guaranteed and may be less than 6 months.

Working Holiday Visa

Students from countries participating in the Working Holiday Visa program are eligible to study full-time or part-time at Cornerstone Academic College for up to 6 months. Application for a Working Holiday Visa can be made at Canadian consulates or embassies in participating countries.

Student Visa Extension

Applications for visa extensions are given to eligible students on an individual basis upon successful completion of their program. Each applicant must meet with a Cornerstone counselor for consideration.

If you wish to travel to other countries when in Canada, including the USA, you will need to know the visa regulations that apply to you. You can find these by contacting the embassy or consulate of the corresponding country before you depart from your own country.

Homestay

Cornerstone's Canadian homestay program is designed to provide cultural exposure to Canadian family life in a warm and supportive environment. It is your home away from home. Your homestay family will provide you with friendship, care, and an ideal opportunity to use your English and experience Canadian culture. Cornerstone ensures quality homestays

Roomstay

Roomstay is an excellent option for independent students looking for more privacy. Similar to Homestay, students live in single or shared rooms with a communal kitchen for food preparation, a living room and a bathroom. This option does not include meals, making it a cheaper accommodation alternative.

Residence

➤ 89 Chestnut (University of Toronto) / May - August A University of Toronto owned residence Located just north of City Hall. It is 15 minute away by TTC to Cornerstone and 5 minutes to Eaton Centre on foot. In the heart of downtown Toronto, 89 Chestnut Residence is a great place to

call home!

➤ New Horizons Tower

New Horizons Tower is a student residence that offers year round accommodation. Students staying here will have the luxury of an inclusive meal plan, private and shared bedrooms, lounge areas, as well as a great location that is close to school and downtown. This residence also offers weekly house keeping and security throughout the building so students can feel safe.

➤ CCNM

CCNM is located in the North part of the city; a 35-min subway ride away from Cornerstone. The residence is connected with Leslie Subway station. Each floor in the facility features 3 lounges with shared kitchenettes and a balcony, laundry facilities, linen services and 10 large washrooms.

➤ Tartu College Residence

Tartu College Residence is located in the Annex on the corners of Bloor and Madison. It is an independent residence, housing students from the University of Toronto, York University, Ryerson, George Brown and OCAD in an 18-storey building. Laundry facilities are on the 18th floor. Meal plans are available. There is a cafeteria on the main floor and a card can be purchased to add a meal plan.
